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Finished Quilt Size: 63" x 73"
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Irish Chain – Throw Size – 63” x 73”

Materials

2 ¼ yards	Roswell Mill Toile – Vanilla (A)	8438-44
1 ¼ yards	Small Leaf – Red (B)	8441-88
1 yard	Tossed Wheat – Brown (C)	8439-38
2 yards	Master Floral – Red (D)	8437-88
4 yards	Roswell Mill Toile – Red (backing)	8438-88

NOTE:

We prefer to cut **Outer Border** strips lengthwise of fabric (LOF) so they do not have to be pieced. This provides for **Binding** strips to be same fabric as **Outer Border**.

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Roswell Mill Toile – Vanilla (A), cut:

- (2) 6½” x WOF strips; used in strip sets
- (4) 2½” x WOF strips; used in strip sets
- Fussy cut (15) 6½” x 10½” rectangles, center each on a scene from remaining fabric

From the Small Leaf – Red (B), cut:

- (16) 2½” x WOF strips; used in strip sets

From the Tossed Wheat – Brown (C):

- (9) 2½” x WOF strips; used in strip sets
- (3) 2” x WOF strips; **Inner Border** – sides
- (3) 2” x WOF strips; **Inner Border** – top/bottom

From the Master Floral – Red (D), cut:

- (4) 5½” x LOF strips; **Outer Border** – sides, top and bottom
- (4) 2½” x LOF strips; for binding

From the Roswell Mill Toile – Red (backing), cut:

- (2) 72” x WOF strips for backing

Irish Chain – Throw Size – 63" x 73"

Block Assembly Instructions

Block One – Strip Set #1

1. Sew (2) 2½" Fabric C strips, (2) 2½" Fabric B strips and (1) 2½" Fabric A strip together in order as shown in Figure 1. Make (2) strip sets total. Sub-cut into (30) 2½" x 10½" sections.

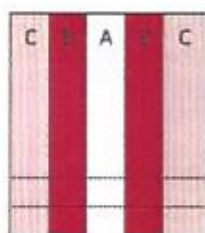

Block One – Strip Set #2

2. Sew (3) 2½" Fabric B strips and (2) 2½" Fabric C strip together in order as shown in Figure 2. Make (2) strip sets total. Sub-cut into (30) 2½" x 10½" sections.

Block One – Strip Set #3

3. Sew (2) 2½" Fabric A strips, (2) 2½" Fabric B strips and (1) 2½" Fabric C strip together in order as shown in Figure 3. Make (1) strip sets total. Sub-cut into (15) 2½" x 10½" sections.
4. To make (1) Block One square, sew (2) 2½" x 10½" Strip Set #1 sections, (2) 2½" x 10½" Strip Set #2 sections, and (1) 2½" x 10½" Strip Set #3 section (2) together as shown in Figure 4.
- (3) Make a total of (15) Block One squares.

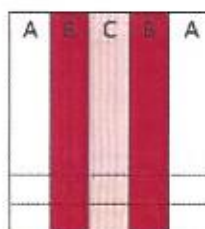

Block Two – Strip Set #4

5. Sew (2) 2½" Fabric B strips and (1) 6½" Fabric A strip together in order shown in Figure 5. Make (2) strip sets total. Sub-cut into (30) 2½" x 10½" sections.
6. To make (1) Block Two square, sew (2) 2½" x 10½" Strip Set #4 sections and (1) 6½" x 10½" Fabric A rectangle (2) together as shown in Figure 6.
- (3) Make a total of (15) Block Two squares

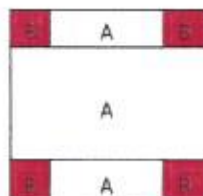

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Photo while assembling).

7. Sew (3) Block One and (2) Block Two together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five.
8. Sew (3) Block Two and (2) Block One together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four and Six.
9. Sew the (6) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
10. Sew (3) 2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end, then cut (2) 2" x 60½" strips for Inner Border – sides. Sew remaining (4) 2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, (5) end to end, then cut (2) 2" x 53½" (6) strips for Inner Border – top/bottom. Sew (1) 2" x 60½" Fabric C to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 53½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
11. Sew (1) 5½" x LOF Fabric D strip to each side of quilt top; trim ends. Sew (1) 5½" x LOF Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top; trim ends.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (4) 2½" x LOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
